

Remarks on the chorology of the Sicilian Salticidae

The Sicilian population of jumping spiders includes 43 species with a vast distribution (cosmopolitan, Holarctic, Palearctic, European, south-European and Mediterranean) and 21 species with a narrow distribution (West-Mediterranean, East-Mediterranean, East-European and endemic). 12 out of the 64 species of Salticidae found in Sicily were not known for the peninsula of Italy until. Of the 71 species known for the southern Italy 16 were had never been reported in Sicily.
